Update on our "Fund for Gary"

One of our season campers, Gary Cosgrove was involved in serious motorcycle crash in Mid August. Gary sustained multiple fractures and numerous other serious injuries. He was transferred to ICU at Sunnybrook hospital in Toronto. (Sunnybrook has one of the best Trauma Care Units in Ontario) Gary faces numerous surgeries, and months or years of rehabilitation. Gary's income is lost indefinitely and his wife Michele' must commute to Toronto to be with him. A "Fund for Gary" was started to assist Gary and Michele through their ordeal. Thus far, we've raised over \$1100.00! This is fabulous but since the need is great we will continue to pass the bucket "For Gary" at future events in hopes of raising as much money as we can to help. Thank you again to all who have generously supported Gary and family.

I'd like to remind campers who store their trailers on site that access to your trailer is limited once your season has ended. Campers are not allowed to drive in the park again until whatever day your season begins next year. You may park in the visitor parking area by the road at the front gate and **walk** to your trailer to rake leaves, or check for weather related damage or mice but are not allowed to hook up to hydro or water until your season begins next year. Anything else requires permission!

When you close your trailer please make sure you disconnect and put away your water hose and electric cord. Sites should be left tidy, dining tents or shelters must be taken down, lawn chairs, ornaments, and garden tools should all be stored in your shed or under your trailer.

Renewal of Season Sites for 2008:

If you're coming back next year, return the completed renewal form with payments for your deposit and winter storage before Sunday September 30th

Special winter storage rates apply only if you put a non-refundable deposit on their site for 2008 and pre-pay your winter storage. Winter Storage Rates are \$30.00 per month if not pre-paid.

Winter storage fees will be charged if any items are left on your site or deck or outside your shed.

This year's season rates will apply for 2008 if pre-paid with a post-dated cheque for Dec.30, 2007. Campers not returning next season must have their site cleared by the end of the 2007 season.

Winterizing Service is available through the park for \$57.50 including taxes. Remember Glenn needs access to all water taps inside your trailer and access to the water heater for winterizing so please make sure he has clear a clear path to them and all the necessary keys. Remember a tag with your name & site number must be attached to your keys!

Sunday, September 30th is the last day 5-month season. Water and hydro must be disconnect by 4:00 pm on the 30th. Plan ahead especially if you're doing your own winterizing, complete it and all necessary repairs or maintenance by the 30th. **Monday, October 15th** is the last day of the 2007 season. Six month campers must have their trailers closed up by this date and must leave the park by 4:00 pm. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Access to trailers is limited in the off-season. Vehicle access is not permitted. You may park in the visitor parking area and walk to your trailer to do a security check or to rake leaves.

Warning to campers who are leaving their larger holding tank valve open

It is important to make sure the larger holding tank valve is closed all the times except when you are emptying the tank. Use holding tank chemicals to combat odours, but use your holding tank!

To dump your tank: close the smaller grey-water valve, then **open** the larger valve. **Rinse** the tank if desired (recommended), then **Close** the larger valve and then **open** the smaller valve.

Leaving the larger valve open on your large holding tank will cause your system to plug up with solids. This problem will likely give you a major headache and cost hundreds of dollars to repair! There's no delicate way to put it; when your holding tank is blocked with paper and shit it's your problem (not ours) and no one will want to repair it!
